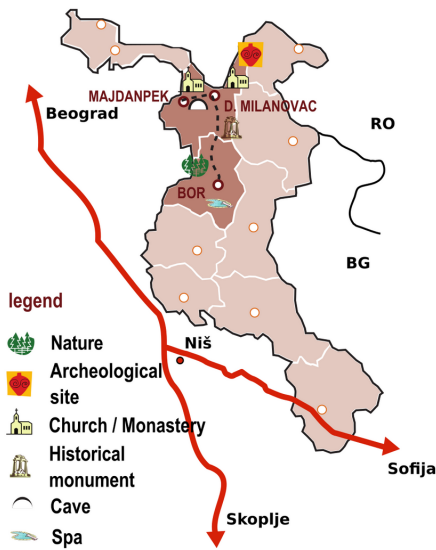


# COPPER ROUTE

## Majdanpek - Bor - 2 days



### DAY 1:

#### **Majdanpek**

Unique experience of panoramic sightseeing of the open pit mine in Majdanpek, second largest surface copper mine in Serbia.

#### **Visit Church of St. Apostles Peter and Paul**

The Church was built in mid 19th century, in a so-called Swiss style. Miners from Majdanpek chose the Apostles for their protectors, so now the Church and the Miners' Holyday fall on the same day, as a great town festivity.

**Rajko's cave** – one of the most beautiful caves in Serbia. The cave was named after the famous Duke Rajko who, as the story goes, used to rob from Turks in the daylight and hide the loot in the cave at night. A presentation (animation) of the process of washing gold is prepared for visitors.

#### **Donji Milanovac**

Visit of **Captain Miša's konak** (residence) and **Tenka's house**. Reconstructed 19th century houses, with authentic exteriors and interiors. Tourist Organisation of the Municipality of Majdanpek has its offices in the Tenka's house.

**Church of Saint Nicolas in Donji Milanovac**. The church was first mentioned in historic documents in 1730, and it is characteristic for a cross, recently brought from Jerusalem, whose parts are built from dust from the cave in which Jesus Christ was born, as well as from dust from His grave.

### DAY 2:

#### **Archaeological site Lepenski vir**

It is a prehistoric site of extraordinary importance, where activity of a human society from 8,500 years ago is exhibited. The site also includes **Museum Lepenski vir**, ethno-houses, with authentic tools and objects.

#### **Bor**

Panoramic sightseeing of Bor and the open pit mine of one of the largest copper mines in Europe. Visit includes sightseeing of French architecture in Bor (Building of the Mining faculty, French casino, Administrative building of RBN, Hospital).

Visit **Museum** in Bor, with its unique permanent exhibition on mining and metallurgy and history of mining in this region.

Visit to the **Zoo** in Bor, one of the most beautiful in Serbia. On an area of about 2 ha, the garden is home to more than 70 species of animals or over 130 individuals.

#### **Brestovačka banja (spa)**

The spa in the vicinity of Bor which is characterized by Turkish spa (hamam) with a thermal water source. **Knyaz Miloš's Konak** (residence) is within the spa, with an exhibition from the Museum of Mining and Metallurgy.
